I placed my order for a standard Firenock on a Wednesday and received it Friday, talk about fast! I wasted no time ripping the package apart and like an idiot didnt read any instructions on it I installed the battery and took an arrow out to test it. After shooting it I noticed that it was VERY dim and could hardly be seen unless cupped in my hand I went back and read the instructions and figured out that I had shorted the battery out by touching the pin on the wire that holds it in once again, my fault!

So I sent a PM to Firenock himself, Dorge Huang, and got a PM back right away saying to give him a call. Before I could pick up the phone, he calls me! Once again, great service. I ended up talking to Dorge for a good while and he offered to send me replacement batteries since he was sure that was the problem. Well, I received the batteries today and finally got to see what the Firenock is about! These things ROCK! I shot AT LEAST 200 shots and it worked flawlessly everytime! I shot it from 60 yards several times in full daylight and had no problems tracking the flight path. At longer ranges it did hit slightly lower but nothing bad at all, at the worst maybe 2 inches at 60 yards. There are only two things that are kind of bug me 1. Battery installment is a little tricky, you just have to be careful. 2. After shutting the nock off several times, the end of the nock starts to get a little beat up. If you use something slightly softer it would last a long time but I wouldnt expect it to last a long time shutting it off on a rock a bunch of times. All and all the Firenock is the best lighted nock I have used and will be in my quiver this fall for SURE!
