Firenock GFH (advance placement public testing)

This is my review of the Firenocks received from Dorge on the special field test trial deal of the first five sets of Firenocks. The delivery from Dorge was very quick.

First off, I have never used any kind of lighted nocks before, so nothing to compare to. However I have been a bowhunter for about 50 years, so I do know a good or a bad product when I use it.

Upon opening the package, I found a product that was professionally constructed, and well thought out. My first problem was trying to install the battery, took several attempts with my big clumsy fingers before success. Then it was trial and error with the O rings. After finding the right O ring the Firenocks fit the arrow very tight.

Now for the test on the bow, shooting into a block target at 30 yards several times, it was fun watching the arrow arc to the target. They were very bright. I at first had a little trouble getting the Firenocks to turn off, that was my fault until I learned how much force to use.

I continued shooting each Firenock several times and had no failures as the nocks performed as advertised. I will use the Firenocks for hunting as I can see the benefits of knowing where your arrow strikes your animal. Also would be helpful in tracking and locating a downed animal.

From my observations, I believe the Firenocks are a excellent product and will continue to use them.
