Hey man. I've been hunting hard since the 15th, and I don't even know where that nock is anymore.

I got to see one in action the morning of the 18th when I shot a doe at 30 yards. She was skittish as heck, and just before the arrow got there, she ducked and wheeled away from the arrow and I stuck her solidly in the upper shoulderbone. I never found one drop of blood, and that was one expensive duck and whirl. The nock worked very well and I could tell from having the nock on there that my arrow flight was perfect, the shot was good, and I hit her forward and high due to her evasive maneuver. Had I not had the lighted nock, I would be second guessing everything from flight to penetration of my arrow to broadhead choice. The nocks work well, and I will be ordering another set soon. I think I'm going to go with the red this time, though. I actually used the other nock on a shot yesterday that hit a limb and sailed way over the deer's back.

Again, the nock let me see the whole shot play out and know what happened. Luckily another fat nanny trapsed by at twenty yards about two minutes later and she is now in the freezer! I'll get back with you tomorrow about the order
