Firenock GS

Got my three pack along with the practice inserts in July was trying to get into the July 4th special but it was already gone so the 3 pack s series it was.

In stalled them into my wrapped 400 ics bemin arrows and with the field point they were working great. After weeks of shooting them I started to try them with my 100gr. thunderheads. The firenocks were still working great but now the broadhead arrow firenocks were not shooting where the same arrows were shooting with no firenocks. Checked the f.o.c. a big difference of course during a random post Dorge sent in his comment that the combination of blazers wraps and the broadhead I was using might be right on the edge of changing the spine. So I tryed same arrow which had some feathers on them, they worked great. Now after about 3/4 weeks of testing shooting etc. one of the firenocks started to light then wouldn't light.

I called Dorge and he told me to check with another battery, I did it worked for a while and stated to give me light, not light. So I sent it back, of course I got a replacement noquestions asked, an a three pack of free batteries. As I have posted before want a quality product then buy from a great company like firenock you won't be dissapointed. Can't wait to get one bloody on Oct. 13th. And yes dorge I put some bow wax around the nock.
