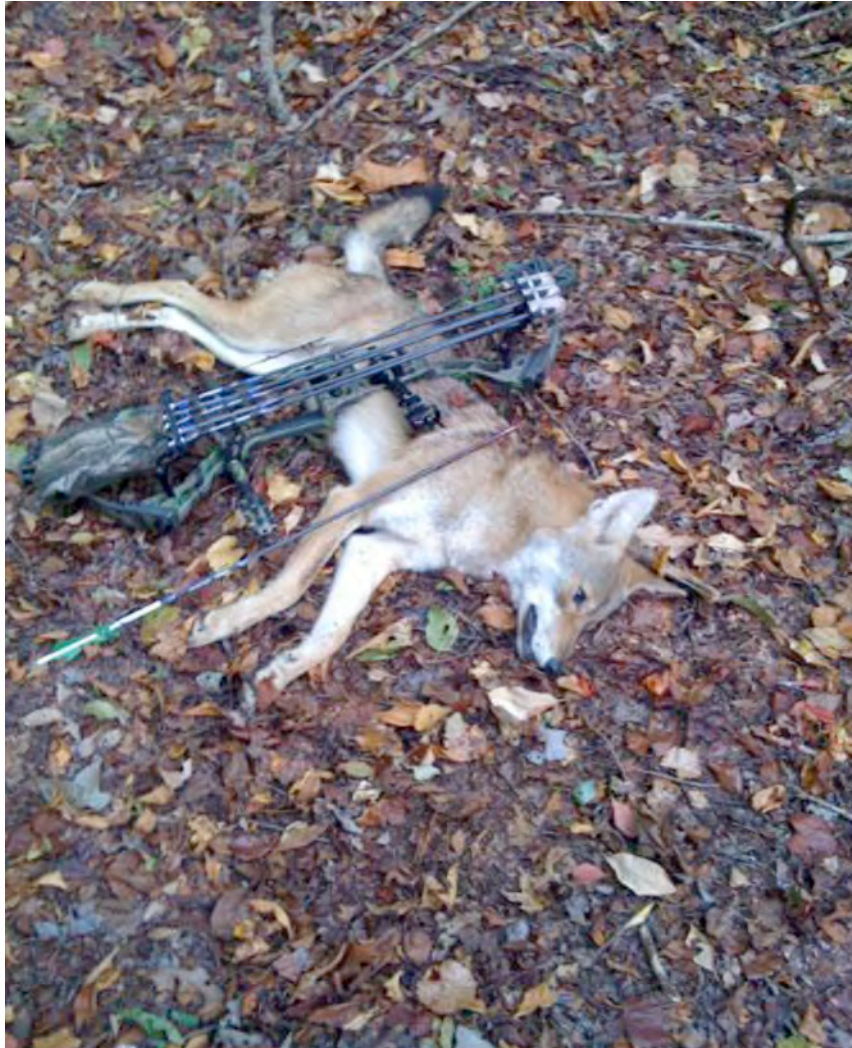
Well, I got my answer shortly after i received my nocks in the mail (which was only a couple days after i placed the order). I quickly installed them into my hunting arrows and headed out back to put them through there paces. Right away I knew that Firenock was superior to any lighted nock I have tried. The brightness of Firenock was incredible; not to mention how cool is it that they install in seconds and no magnet is need to activate.

After shooting up until almost dark I decided to go back in the house and visually inspect my new toy. After removing a Firenock from one of my arrows the first thing that I noticed was the quality. It was

just amazing to a simple Bowhunter like me that so much technology could be built into such a small product. The other thing I liked was I did not have to do anything to install them except install the battery and

insert it into the arrow shaft.

My only regret is that I did not purchase my Firenocks a lot sooner, So my advice to all you skeptics out there is to just break down and get you some Firenocks you wont be sorry.



FIELD UPDATE:

I have them and shot a coyote Sat. morning and then shot a doe Sat. night with the same one I did get the arrow broke off because of a hard quartering away shot and the arrow shaft filled up with blood and the **Firenock** quit working so when I got home I washed the **Firenock** in warm water let dry and then installed a new battery and viola just like new.
